

Budget/Precept 2025/26

The Town Council at their January meeting resolved to set the precept at £150,000 the same as 2024/25. The average band D property will decrease slightly to £87.24 from £87.60 per year.

The graph below shows how the council's annual budget compares to if we'd increased inline with RPI over the last 8 years vs our actual increases during this period.



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2024-26 Projects

At the end of this year 2024/25 the council are embarking on the 2nd stage of the refurbishment of the Phil Grundy Centre and engaging with a Planning Agent to take the project and obtain full planning permission. In the 2025/26 financial year the Town Council will then look to move forward in obtaining grant funding to realise this project.

Service Provisions:

Community & Civic Events – Firework Event, Civic Service, Civic Dinner, Christmas Tree & Light Switch on, Christmas Light Competition, Best Kept Village/East Midlands in Bloom – hanging baskets, planting.

Maintenance of town assets - War Memorial, Allotments, Cemetery – trees & memorial surveys, Broughton Village Hall Clock Tower, Phil Grundy Sports & Community Centre, War Memorial Recreation Field, Skatepark & play park, Closed Churchyard & Extension – tree surveys, lych gate & walls, planters, benches.

Financial Support - Allotments, In Bloom Group, Broughton Village Hall, local groups.

Central Administration – provisions for the town council's administration and establishment includes mayoral functions, annual town award and remembrance Sunday parade. As a consultee, the town council considers and comments on local planning applications to the local Planning Authority at North Lincolnshire Council.
